


AKTAU International Airport

Why Aktau?

- The trading position of the Caspian region develops commercial potential.
- Potential intermodal transportation system air, rail / sea, road can generate additional income.
- The presence of a maritime connection with Baku has unrealized potential for increasing trade and income.
- Availability of the Railway Kazakhstan Turkmenistan Iran of the international transport corridor North South the railway, built in 2009-2014 in Central Asia, connecting Kazakhstan, Turkmenistan and Iran.
- Investments in the modernization of roads and railways demonstrate a political and economic focus on transport and logistics, including strategic and financial support.
- The construction of the SEZ (FREE ECONOMIC ZONE) demonstrates the focus and vision of attracting foreign investment, creating conditions for business, and supporting trade and employment of the population.
- Exemption of SEZ participants from taxes on profits, land and property.
- The possibility of exemption from customs duties for the participants of the FEZ.

Aktau seaport has 12 berths in length 1550 m, and is ready to serve 4
vessels at the same time. The capacity of the Aktau seaport allows
the annual transshipment of 10 million tons of oil and 1.5 million tons
of dry cargo.

• Aktau port is one of the most modern ports in the Caspian region and is a strategic evil at the crossroads of Asia and Europe.

 The Kyryk Port is well located at the intersection of the East-West trade corridors (One Belt, One Way) and the North-South corridors (India, Russia), creating one of the fastest multimodal routes for cargo delivery.

• The railway is the main mode of transportation (80%) when it comes to the transportation of coal, oil, metal. The length of the railways in Kazakhstan is 13.6 thousand km, including more than 5000 km of double railway lines.


